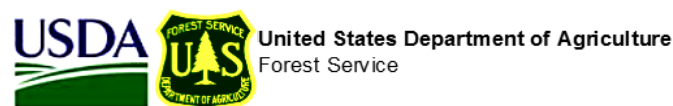

- **Access & Senior (Lifetime and Annual) Passes** 50% off basic campsite. **Military Passes** may not be used for camping discounts.
- **Access & Senior (Lifetime and Annual) Passes** 50% off general admission to Homeplace 1850s Farm, Nature Station, and Planetarium
- **Military Passes*** | Provides veteran & active duty military service members or their spouse and three other individuals free general admission, **Monday through Friday only** to Homeplace 1850s Farm, Nature Station, and Planetarium
- **Gold Star Family Voucher*** | Provides gold star family members and three other individuals free admission, **Monday through Friday only to the Homeplace 1850s Farm, Nature Station, and Planetarium.**

Reservations can be made up to six months in advance and no less than two days before arrival.

Late Cancellations	\$10 plus one night camping fee if cancelled less than three days from reservation date

Cabins

No pets and no smoking in cabins. Cabins include:

Inside: One full bed and two bunks (twin and full each) at Energy, eight and four person cabins at Piney (call Piney for details), and one full bed with either one or three bunks at Wranglers.

Heater/air conditioner, ceiling fan with light, small table, folding chairs or benches, and electrical outlets.

Outside: Restroom/shower buildings are located in campgrounds near cabins. Piney and Wranglers also have an Outpost for camping supplies and rentals.
