There is no need to register, just show up and bring a friend! Everyone is welcome. General admission covers all programs and activities: \$5 ages 12 and up, \$3 ages 5-12, free for ages 4 and under. Plan to spend at least 3 hours to complete all activities. Most activities will be outdoors.
