## Celebrate Independence Day at the Homeplace

Land Between the Lakes, Ky./Tenn. June 22, 2018 - The public is invited to a
traditional community celebration of
America's birthday at the Homeplace 1850s
Working Farm, from 1-4 p.m., July 4.
Admission is \$5 ages 13 and up; \$3 ages
5 -12; free for ages 4 and under.

"Raising the 30 star flag from 1850 and reading the Declaration of Independence together is a moving way to remember why we still celebrate today," says Erik Waywood, Homeplace interpreter. "We are also planning a special finish, called



Sounds of the Fourth, with patriotic toasts (lemonade provided), songs, bells and more. Help us bring the afternoon to a rousing close. There will also be a launch of a small hot air or "smoke" balloon, weather permitting."

Throughout the afternoon visitors can take part in old time games, crafts, ice cold water melon, and a pie eating contest. Guests are encouraged to bring lawn chairs or blankets. The Homeplace 1850s Working Farm recreates the lifestyle of a two-generation family of the region. Visitors mingle with interpreters wearing period attire going about their daily chores. Artifacts, restored historic structures and traditional seasonal activities take visitors back-in-time to relive history before the American Civil War.
