Wildlife Refuges Reopen at Land Between the Lakes

Land Between the Lakes, Ky./Tenn. - March 16, 2023 - The USDA Forest Service at Land Between the Lakes National Recreation Area reopens its wildlife refuges to human entry after they were closed this winter to provide waterfowl, shorebirds, and bald eagles needed sanctuary.

The reopened wildlife refuges include:

- Bards, Duncan, Energy, Hematite, and Honker Lakes
- Duncan, Rushing, and Smith Bays on Kentucky Lake
- Fulton and Honker Bays on Lake Barkley
- Long Creek Refuge

Wildlife refuges are closed seasonally from Nov. 1 - March
