ACTION: Notice of Availability of an Environmental Assessment

SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given that the USDA-FS, as required by the National Environmental Policy Act, is issuing an environmental assessment (EA) in connection with efforts to eradicate non-native invasive plant species on Land Between the Lakes, National Recreation Area (NRA). The proposal is for a comprehensive approach to eradication through the use of multiple methods and covers the entire NRA.

****SPECIAL NOTE**: The intent of this EA is to establish a consistent, programmatic method for addressing non-native, invasive plant species (NNIPS), and for maintaining stakeholder engagement and public involvement. This EA does not specify specific project areas or tools to be used for a specific NNIPS problem. The NRA will produce an Annual Operating Plan (AOP) to be released to the public by the end of the 1st quarter of each fiscal year. One of the items included in this plan will be the previous year's project results (except for the first plan produced in 2025). The plan will also include detailed analysis of the upcoming year's proposed project. The AOP will have specific project areas, proposed actions, effects, design features, best management practices, and maps. Again, these notifications will be annual and afford the public an opportunity to comment on proposed projects and to engage in project design.
